Additional requirements:

1. Must be in (MUL) private lessons for a minimum of seven semesters.
2. Must be in Wind Symphony or University Orchestra for a minimum of seven semesters.
3. Must fulfill Recital and Concert Attendance requirement.
4. Music majors must register for MUS 195 each semester in residence, except when they are either enrolled in an Introduction to Music Education course or EDU 492 and EDU 495.
5. Must pass the piano proficiency exam before student teaching.
6. Must complete proficiency level 3 on a band or orchestral instrument.
7. At the conclusion of MUS 204 Keyboard Skills II, students are required to take the piano proficiency exam. A failing grade on the piano proficiency exam will result in students being required to take private piano lessons.

3. Must fulfill Recital and Concert Attendance requirement.
4. Music majors must register for MUS 195 each semester in residence, except when they are either enrolled in an Introduction to Music Education course or EDU 492 and EDU 495.
5. Must pass the piano proficiency exam before student teaching.
6. At the conclusion of MUS 204 Keyboard Skills II, students are required to take the piano proficiency exam. A failing grade on the piano proficiency exam will result in students being required to take private piano lessons.
7. Must major in voice and complete proficiency level 3. (Keyboard majors must achieve the department's stated vocal proficiency in lieu of majoring in voice.)
